Learning Across the Curriculum and Wider Achievement

Euan is a cheerful, motivated and friendly boy who consistently follows school and class rules. He is conscientious and always completes work to a high standard. Euan is developing relationships with his peers and enjoys sharing news with them. It is nice to hear about Euan's Rugby achievements. Euan deals positively with praise but can sometimes get frustrated with setbacks as he takes a great deal of pride in his work and likes it to be perfect. This said, he is beginning to realise that it is not a bad thing to get something wrong. Euan has enjoyed participating in our Glee project. He also enjoyed our trip to Dundee Science Centre. It has been a pleasure teaching Euan and I wish him well for Primary 5.

Language and Literacy

Euan is making excellent progress within first level. He always listens well and follows all instructions. Euan enjoys sharing facts and opinions with his peers. He is an able reader and reads fluently with excellent expression. Euan can write detailed stories including story elements such as setting and characterisation. He can use paragraphs to mark significant changes of events or time. He has developed the skill of proofreading his work and referring back to the success criteria. He is able to make suggestions on how to improve his work. Next Euan should develop his use of punctuation in his writing.

Mathematics and Numeracy

Euan has developed his understanding of the number system and can with some support work with numbers over 10000. He can add and subtract numbers and multiply and divide them by a single digits. He is able to calculate a fraction of a number. Euan can tell the time using 12 hour clocks, realising that there is a link with 24 hour notation. He can explain how it impacts on his daily routine and ensures that he is organised and ready for events throughout the day. Euan has explored 3D objects and 2D shapes and can identify, name and describe their features using appropriate vocabulary. Euan should continue to practise his times tables.

Health and Wellbeing

Euan has shown a good level of effort throughout the year in PE. He has shown a willingness to try and improve his performance and can contribute positively to class discussions. Some further practice at basic motor skills could perhaps be of benefit. (Miss Ward)

Euan has a good understanding of children's rights and can make connections between his rights and aspects of his daily routine. Euan enjoyed learning about how to help others in an emergency situation. He showed his learning through a short role play where he successfully placed someone into the recovery position. (Miss Grant)

Expressive Arts

Euan is developing a range of skills through exploring different techniques in art. Euan has demonstrated a good level of competency in handling different art materials. (Mrs Kennedy)
Euan has shown enthusiasm during our Glee project. He was able keep the beat and rhythm of the songs. Euan managed to learn a series of dance moves and has demonstrated he can perform confidently in front of an audience. When participating in drama lessons Euan was able to sustain a given role. During our class assembly Euan was enthusiastic and clearly said his lines with confidence.

Religious and Moral Education

Euan has a good understanding of the key features, traditions and teachings of the Islamic faith. He is able to recognise images and artifacts relevant to Islam, and knows some of the stories central to their beliefs. He can confidently name the features of a Christian church and is knowledgeable about how Christian communities demonstrate their beliefs through prayer and worship in holy buildings. Euan has explored in detail the Christian nativity and Easter narrative and can confidently identify links between these stories and his own celebration of the festivals. Next steps: To identify Christian values and how they feature in his own life. (Mrs Topen)

Sciences

During our electricity topic Euan worked with a partner to combine simple components in a series circuit to make a light bulb light up. He understands that mains electricity is dangerous and knows how to keep himself safe. He can identify materials which are conductors and insulators. From exploring the seashore Euan can describe different habitats found there. He is able to give examples of food chains. Euan understands that food chains are started by energy from sunlight. Throughout our Space topic Euan has learned about the features of the earth, sun and moon. He understands that sun is the source of light and heat. Euan can describe some of the features of the planets.

Social Subjects

Throughout our seashore topic Euan has explored climate zones around the world, he can compare and describe how climate affects living things. Euan explored how the local landscape of Broughty Ferry is used and can describe the various ways in which the land has been used. From exploring the daily lives of Roman soldiers Euan can explain the roles and responsibilities they had. He is aware of the different social classes in Roman times and is able to describe the different types of housing each social class had. He worked as part of a small group to plan an interesting activity for the Roman Feast. Euan's research topic homework is always completed to a high standard and demonstrates excellent research skills.

Technologies

Euan can log on to the computer independently and access programs to enhance learning e.g. Education City. He can use PowerPoint to create a slideshow including animation, graphics and text. Euan has enjoyed sharing his PowerPoints with the class. He can access, retrieve and use information from electronic sources to support and extend learning in different contexts for example finding information on a website during our Roman topic. Euan has enjoyed designing and creating models using lego and junk modeling materials. He was able to suggest ways to improve them. Next steps, Euan should continue to develop his keyboard skills.

Modern Languages

Euan has enjoyed participating in French lessons this year. He is able to say basic greetings and he can respond to some questions for example how are you? Using this knowledge he is able to have a short conversation with a partner. Euan is able to say the days of the week and months of the year. He is able to count to ten in French and also identify the number names in French. Euan enjoyed participating in our French food tasting sessions and had fun ordering food in French at our French cafe role play area. Next, Euan will learn vocabulary about the weather.
